Visiting the Kindergarten "Djecji svijet"

The Erasmus+ Project COLINC, is a partnership of schools from 5 European countries: Croatia, Greece, Italy, Slovenia and Portugal. The main objective of the project is to share educational practices to improve the inclusion of all children within the framework of early childhood education.

In the week from 14-18.10. Kindergarten "Djecji svijet" hosted the first LTT in the project. The meeting of all partners enabled excellent communication, collaboration, quick solutions, innovations for improving project work and teamwork.

The main importance of partners visit, was the opportunity to actively participate in the activities, where the partners had firsthand opportunities to see and experience how inclusion of a child with special needs works, since 2-10 children with special needs have always been involved in all activities.



The work sessions allowed partners to know and reflect on the policies of inclusive education in each of the countries.

Partners participated in and attended all activities kindergarten provides alone or in collaboration with the local community: regular program in indoor and outdoor of kindergarten, activities outside kindergarten in collaboration with another institution, outdoor activities



in the public, workshops with parents, visited performances for children at the Croatian National Theater, visit and workshop at the Varaždin City Museum (Entomological Museum), activity in cooperation with the parent, participation in activities in nature according to the principles of forest pedagogy.

The partner teachers appreciated the autonomous participation of the children in the wide range of situations they could observe.

The warm welcome the city of Varazdin gave to the team of partners also contributed to the success of this event.
